

Admissions Criteria

Walmer Road School is an independent school and as such, is entitled to set out its own admissions criteria. This School believes in and promotes equal opportunities. All referred students will be considered. The proprietor reserves the right to admit students according to the following criteria:

- Students who have withdrawn or are about to be withdrawn from main stream education.
- Students displaying a need for more individual attention where such support is not available in their current educational setting.
- Students whose application is supported by a report and records from a referring school or LEA representative.
- Students are between 14 to 16 years old.
- Students display a positive attitude to work and willingness to learn.
- Students are prepared to agree that their behavior would not undermine their education or the education of others.
- Students whose parents or carers support admission to the school, visit the school and engage positively with the school and staff.
- Students who agree to abide by the rules and values of The Rugby Portobello Trust of which Walmer Road School is a part.

Please note that priority of entry to Walmer Road School will be given to students living in the Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea, though consideration will be given to suitable students from neighbouring boroughs.
