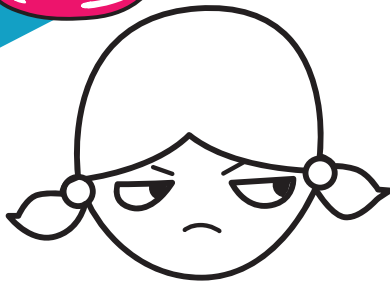

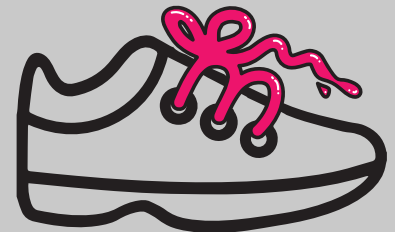
Imagine if your friend Tim asked you

(And besides, it might get dirty, hanging about on his feet all day)

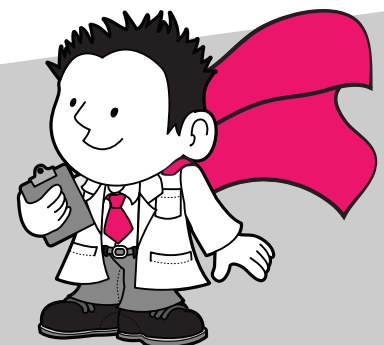
Unlike Tim,
